
A TALK WITH AN ALUMNAE






The inter-batch dialogue with seniors was a great help for freshers. In the end, freshers felt motivated and appreciated this session.












CONCLUSION







A REPORT ON TRANSFORMATION TECHNOLOGY


A programme on "Transformation Technology (Think to transform) "was conducted as a part of Students' Induction Programme on 18 Dec, 2021 in KOR Auditorium.






The day began with a visit to the respective department.






CHRISTMAS CELEBRATIONS




AN AWARENESS PROGRAMME ON ROAD SAFETY AND SAFETY MEASURES DURING THIRD WAVE OF COVID.







GUEST LECTURE ON SELF ESTEEM

Self-esteem is your opinion of yourself. Everyone lacks confidence occasionally but people with low self-esteem are unhappy or unsatisfied with themselves most of the time. It takes attention and daily practice to boost a low self-esteem. Self-esteem is your opinion of yourself. People with healthy self-esteem like themselves and value their achievements. This can be remedied but it takes attention and daily practise to boost self-esteem. Self-esteem is strongly related to how you view and react to the things that happen in your life. Suggestions for building self-esteem include:

- Talk to yourself positively treat yourself as you would your best friend. Be supportive, kind and understanding. Don't be hard on yourself when you make a mistake.
- Challenge negative 'self-talk' every time you criticise yourself, stop and look for objective evidence that the criticism is true. (If you feel you can't be objective, then ask a trusted friend for their opinion.) You'll realise that most of your negative self-talk is unfounded.


SPORTS





























19.07.2018 -Ted talks event conducted by M.Purushotham Reddy (Asst.Prof, CSE, K.S.R.M.C.E)




