

Workshop on MATLAB
Simulation and Its
Applications


Centre for Research and Innovation (CRI) conducted a three Day' Workshop on *MATLAB Simulation and Its Applications* from 17.12.2020 to 19.12.2020 at 3.00 pm to 5:00 pm. Around thirty five students from E.E.E & E.C.E have participated in the event. Dr. T.

Mariprasath acted as the resource person for the workshop. On Day one, the resource person trained the students to modeling and analysis of Switched Reluctance Motor (SRM) by Simcape toolbox. Subsequently, various speed control techniques have been developed and evaluated its significance by the MATLAB Simulink block set. On Day 2, the resource person demonstrated on how to use the MATLAB function block for

implementing various MPPT algorithms for enhancing the output voltage of solar PV systems. Besides, impact of buck and boost converters on the solar PV system has been studied by Simulation. Day 3, the resource person, covered the topic i.e. 5kWp-Solar PV system modelling and analysis with buck-boost converter.

Furthermore, a comparative analysis between Perturb and Observation, incremental and conductance algorithm has been implemented on the above developed model. The outcome of the workshop is, students are able to build models and analysis by using Simscape and Simpower system toolbox.

The BJP led Government in 2015 declared 26 November as Constitution Day by a gazette notification on 19 November.

What is the Preamble to the Constitution of India?

"WE, THE PEOPLE OF INDIA, having solemnly resolved to constitute India into a SOVEREIGN SOCIALIST SECULAR DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC and to secure to all its citizens:JUSTICE, social, economic, and political;LIBERTY thought, expression, belief, faith, and worship; EQUALITY of status and of opportunity; and to promote among them allFRATERNITY assuring the dignity of the individual and the unity and integrity of the Nation; IN OUR CONSTITUENT ASSEMBLY this twenty-sixth day of November, 1949, do HEREBY ADOPT, ENACT AND GIVE TO OURSELVES THIS CONSTITUTION."

The Constitution of India declares India a sovereign, socialist, secular, democratic republic, assuring its citizen's justice, equality, and liberty and endeavours to promote fraternity. The **preamble** was amended by the 42nd Constitutional Amendment Act in 1976, in which three new words Socialist, Secular, and Integrity were added.

Let us tell you that, the Indian Constitution describes the fundamental political code, structure, procedures, powers, and duties of the government institutions. It also explains **fundamental rights**, directive principles, and the **duties of citizens**. India's constitution is the longest written constitution in the world. It took around 2 years, 11 months, and 17 days to complete the Constitution.

Therefore, Constitution Day of India is celebrated on 26 November to commemorate the adoption of the Constitution of India.


members participated in the online quiz. For all the participants, e-certificate has been issued. Sri. P. Durga Prasad acted as the coordinator of the programme.


